

## Holywater

### APPLICATION METHODS

Penetrant treatments with Holywater must be made, possibly, in conjunction with any aeration technique, starting from micro spiking to hollow tine coring  
For soil water penetration and surface water removal during the growing season: 10 liters/ha in 800 liters of water. Water in thoroughly  
To improve drainage in wintertime on football pitches and fairways: 10 liters/ha in 800 liters of water..  
For sodium and bicarbonates leaching on sandy soils: 10 liters/ha in 800 liters of water. Use monthly throughout the irrigation season. The application interval may be adjusted as needed. Water in thoroughly; product has to penetrate into soil profile.
